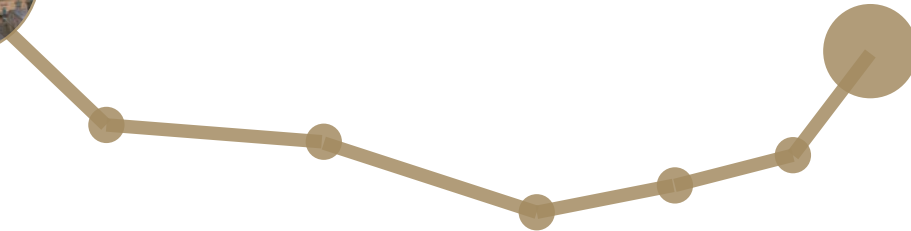

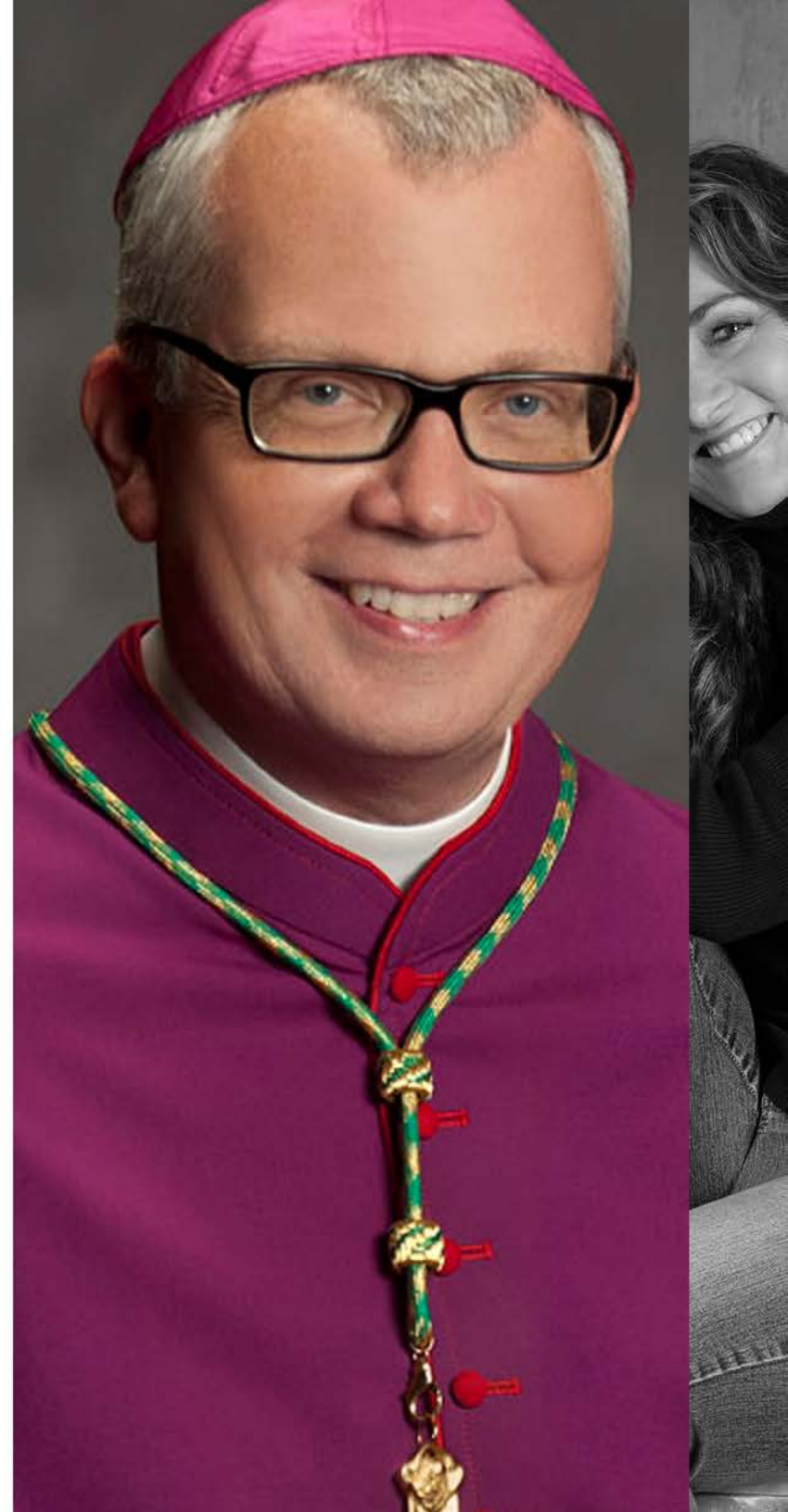

MEET OUR NARRATOR

BISHOP DONALD JOSEPH HYING

The youngest of six sons, Bishop Donald Joseph Hying was born in West Allis, Wisconsin, to parents Albert and Catherine Hying on August 18, 1963. On May 20, 1989, Bishop Hying was ordained a priest for the Archdiocese of Milwaukee. Pope Benedict XVI appointed Fr. Donald Hying the Titular Bishop of Regiae and Auxiliary Bishop of the Archdiocese of Milwaukee and he was consecrated a bishop on July 20, 2011 by Most Reverend Jerome Edward ListECKI, Archbishop of Milwaukee. His Holiness, Pope Francis, appointed him as the Fourth Bishop of Gary (Indiana) where he served from 2015-2019. He has been serving as the Fifth Bishop of Madison (Wisconsin) since he was installed on June 25, 2019.

Bishop Hying serves as the Episcopal Liaison for the National Association of Catholic Chaplains and as Episcopal Advisor to the U.S. Society of St. Vincent de Paul. He is also a member of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops' Subcommittee to Aid the Church in Central and Eastern Europe and the Committee on the Protection of Children and Young People and the Committee on Catholic Education.





THE DIRECTOR

ERIN BERGHOUSE

With more than 80 film productions in the past decade, international award-winning composer/producer Erin Berghouse has made a remarkable impact on the music and faith-based film industry. She is the Founder and President of Ahava Productions, an avant-garde 501(c)(3) nonprofit that creates films with the sole purpose of reaffirming the depth and beauty of the Catholic faith. In 2017, Erin produced ECHO—a series of 72 captivating short films on the Catechism of the Catholic Church featuring Bishop Donald Hying (www.ahavaproductions.com/echo), which was produced over 36 weeks. In 2020, Erin’s visionary storytelling gave birth to Deo Gratias, The Life of Blessed Solanus Casey (www.ahavaproductions.com/solanus). Her latest film, Santiago – THE CAMINO WITHIN, is set to release in select theaters nationwide Tuesday, March 28th.

Before creating Ahava Productions in 2014, Erin established herself as an accomplished composer/musician and performed with well-known artists like Sarah McLachlan, Lisa Loeb, and Natalie Merchant. Her exemplary work has appeared on multiple radio and television networks, including NBC, Fox Sports, Premier Radio Network Productions, The National Federation for Catholic Youth Ministry, EWTN Worldwide Television, Salt and Light Television, FORMED, and National Radio.

Additionally, Erin was chosen as the American composer to perform with the Toronto Symphony Orchestra for the Legacy of Pope John Paul II Productions and collaborated with the American Catholic evangelist and biblical scholar Jeff Cavins. She wrote, directed, and produced the panel on The Impact of Positive Media Productions in our World at World Youth Day 2002 and has written theme songs for the National Multiple Sclerosis and National Muscular Dystrophy organizations and Camp Heartland.

When Erin is not composing or producing, she devotes her time to being a wife, mama, and nana—three roles she embraces wholeheartedly. In 2020 during COVID, Erin and her husband, Brad, embarked on a new journey to get “grounded” and opened Ave Maria Farms, a small lavender farm in North Lake, Wisconsin.
